PRIVATE LESSONS:

Solos - \$29.00 per ½ hour, Duets- \$33.00 per ½ hour, Trios - \$37.00 per ½ hour

Ballet Solo – must take 2 – 3 ballet classes each week. This will be determined by the private lesson instructor.

Jazz Solo – must take 1 ballet and 1 jazz class per week. Any student participating in a private lesson (of any kind), must be taking required classes for that discipline. **(See Specialty Class Requirements).**

Please note: All private lesson fees must be paid with tuition.

CHOREOGRAPHY FEES:

No choreography fee for solos, duets or trios for recital routines

REGISTRATION FEE:

\$37.00 per child for new students, \$32.00 for returning students, \$50.00 family rate. This fee is non-refundable.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

WE ACCEPT CASH OR CHECK ONLY We try to keep our prices as reasonable as possible and credit card service charges have gotten extremely expensive. We do not want to increase prices or charge fees for credit card usage.

- Please no postdated checks. If a check is not ready to be deposited, then it will be considered late and the \$25.00 late charge will be assessed.
- A \$25.00 service charge will be assessed for all return checks.
- A 5% discount will be issued to all siblings after the oldest child.
- New students only are offered (1) one free trial class in each subject to determine which class (s) your child is interested in taking.
- For those of you who would like to pay the year up-front (which will be 38 weeks) a 5% discount will be applied to each child's yearly tuition. You will need to make this decision at the time of registration, you may not decide in the middle of the year.

PLEASE NOTE: Registration for any/each class should be listed very specifically. Example: Tues., Jr. Level 2 Ballet.

REFUNDS/COMBINING OF CLASSES:

Classes with less than 6 students MAY be omitted, deleted or combined with another class. A refund will be issued if a change does not accommodate your schedule. Missed classes may be made up at another class of equal level. Severe illness or injury can place tuition on a hold status however you need to make us aware of this.

Classes canceled by the studio because of an act of nature, i.e., a hurricane, which is out of our control, will not be made up. If there is any threat of inclement weather, please call the studio and listen to our message since our voice mail is through Bellsouth, you should always be able to hear the current message.

CLASS ATTIRE: Our attire is basic, simple and classical, this keeps all students/all levels looking the same. It helps limit most parents to purchase only one leotard annually. In addition, it is much easier for teachers to notice corrections that need to be made when any student is doing something different from the rest of the class.

Leotards & Tights:

PLAIN Black Leotard (*no skirts, rhinestones or designs*) any Style for all students in any/all classes

Pink Tights with/without seams for all students in any/all classes. This keeps parents from feeling they need to keep buying different leotards.

Shoes:

We **Recommend** Bloch Shoes in the following style numbers. Primarily because we wear Light Tan Bloch tights for Recital which match Bloch Shoes exactly and this brand wears extremely well. However, there are some other Brands that will match properly. If for any reason that your child does not fit into any of these shoes, then you will need to get him/her whatever fits properly. The color & style may be different but, no one belongs in a shoe that does not fit properly. If he/she is wearing something that currently fits, please do not feel compelled to replace them now. Wait until the child out grows them or replace them for the recital.

DANCE BAGS & CONTENTS: Please make sure that your child has a dance bag, preferably with their name on the outside. Make sure that all shoes are labeled with their names and that you check them periodically to see if the label has faded. If so, please re-label them accordingly.

NO jewelry should be worn during classes. (especially no hoop-type earrings or dangling necklaces or bracelets). No street shoes are allowed on the actual dance floor. Students out of uniform will be asked to leave the class.

LATE ARRIVALS:

- **Any student more than 5 minutes late will not be allowed into class. This is for safety reasons, since stretching and preparation begins immediately.**

CLASS ABSENCES:

All Pre Ballet & Tap, Pee Wee Acro, Combo 1, Combo 2, Combo3, Petite Acro, Petite Hip Hop Students:

It is recommended that all students participating in any of these recital routines not miss any more than four classes between August-December and January - June unless advised by a physician. If a student does not know a recital routine, parents will be responsible for makeup classes (if available) or to pay for private lessons.

All Jr & Sr Level Students: are not allowed to miss any more than 4 of each class August- December and January - June unless otherwise advised by a physician. The dancer may either be removed from the routine or the parents will be responsible to pay for private lessons.

CLASS PLACEMENT:

Ages are used as guidelines. Ability, experience, effort and dedication are the main criteria for placement. The completion of a dance year/session does not always general a level change. The curriculum is structured so that advancement takes place as skills are mastered, by each student as an individual.

It is fun for students to dance with their friends, however, friends generally have different strengths and weaknesses. No student will benefit from a class that is too easy or too difficult when it is just to take it with a friend. Therefore, we ask that you trust the judgment of the staff and support our decisions of class placement.

Jr & Sr Level students **ONLY:** Sunday June 12, 2022 prior to recital, black leotard & pink tights, appropriate shoes @ Mid Florida Event Center. **This will be a closed/working rehearsal which means absolutely no spectators.**

Showcases:

Fabulous Feet Dance Center offers students the opportunity to dance in our annual Showcases each year. The Showcases are scheduled for Sunday, June 12, 2022 at Mid Florida Event Center – Port Saint Lucie. This is totally optional, although most students look forward to performing. Photographs (without flash) &/ or videos (without flash or additional lighting) will be allowed at Showcases. Those wanting to set up tripods or cameras that would be considered intrusive on other spectators visible/enjoyment may do so from designated seating, only.

STUDIO CLASSES/REHEARSALS:

All Jr & Sr students participating in Our Showcases are required to be in attendance for any/all classes and/or rehearsals from Tues May 22 thru Sat June 11, additional rehearsals may become necessary for the benefit of the students. You **MUST** be available for any and all extra rehearsals called. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS, OTHER THAN A DOCTORS NOTE FOR A SEVERE ILLNESS, DEATH IN THE FAMILY OR EMERGENCY.**

If any student cannot comply with the Class Absence Limits, Dress Rehearsal Requirement or Mandatory Studio Rehearsals, they should not consider being part of the recital. Technique classes may provide an option for these dancers.

SPECIALTY CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

Acrobatics: Regular Attendance is required for the SAFETY of our students in Acrobatics (Acro). Participation in Acrobatics will require a Separate/additional form to be signed.

Jr Ballet Level 1 - 1 Ballet Class weekly

Jr Ballet Level 2 - 2 Ballet Classes weekly

Jr Ballet Level 3 - 3 Ballet Classes weekly

Sr Ballet Level 1 - 1 Ballet Class weekly

Sr Ballet Level 3 - 3 Ballet Classes weekly, unless approved by Ms Michelle

Sr Ballet Level 4 - 3 Ballet Classes weekly

Contemporary - 1 Ballet or 1 Jazz per week is required. Modern is also recommended.

Lyrical - 1 Ballet or 1 Jazz per week is required. Modern is also recommended.

Modern - 1 Ballet weekly & either 1 Jazz per week or 1 Contemporary per week required

Jr. Pre-Pointe/Pointe - 2 Ballet classes per week, 1 Ballet Class must be right before the Pre-Pointe/Pointe
Sr Pre-Pointe/Pointe - 2 Ballet Classes per week, 1 Ballet Class must be right before the Pre-Pointe/Pointe
Pointe Solos - 3 Ballet Classes per week, unless approved by Ms Michelle. 1 Ballet Class must be right before the Pointe Class
Jr Tap - Level 2 & Level 3, 2 Tap Classes per week are required at Jr Level
Sr Tap Level 2 & Level 3, 2 Tap Classes per week are required at Sr Level
Jr Jazz - Level 3, 2 Jazz Classes per week are required at Jr. Level
Sr Jazz - Level 2 & Level 3, 2 Jazz Classes per week required at Sr Level
